

What is HCAP

The Healthcare Assistance Program (HCAP) operated by the Montgomery County Hospital District (MCHD) provides certain healthcare services to eligible, low income residents of Montgomery County that have no other public or private health care benefits. MCHD does not own or operate a hospital, but contracts for services with local physicians, hospitals, and other providers.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. **Residence** – Must live in Montgomery County
2. **Income** – May not exceed the minimum established FPIL* of 150%
3. **Resources** – May not exceed \$2,000 (or \$3,000 if aged or disabled)
4. **Citizenship** – US Citizens or Resident Aliens
5. **Medical Need** – Must have a medical need of some kind

*Federal Poverty Income Level

Two Plans:

1. **Montgomery County Indigent Care Plan (MCICP) [0-21% FPIL]**
2. **Medical Assistance Plan (MAP) [22-150% FPIL]**
 - The most recent versions of the MCICP and MAP Handbooks are available online
 - Both plans cover the same EXACT services

Basic Services Covered: Physician services, annual physical examinations, immunizations, medical screening services (blood pressure, blood sugar, and cholesterol screening) laboratory and x-ray services, family planning, skilled nursing facility services, prescription drugs (3 RXs/month), rural health clinic services, inpatient hospital services, and outpatient hospital services.

Extended Services Covered: Advanced practice nurse services, ambulatory surgical center (freestanding) services, catastrophic oncology services, colostomy medical supplies, diabetic medical supplies and equipment, durable medical equipment (DME), emergency medical services (EMS), home and community health care services (in special circumstances with authorization), mental health services, physician assistant services, and federally qualified health center services (FQHC).
